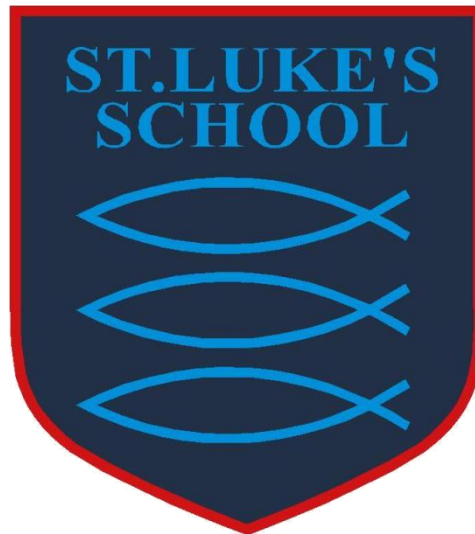


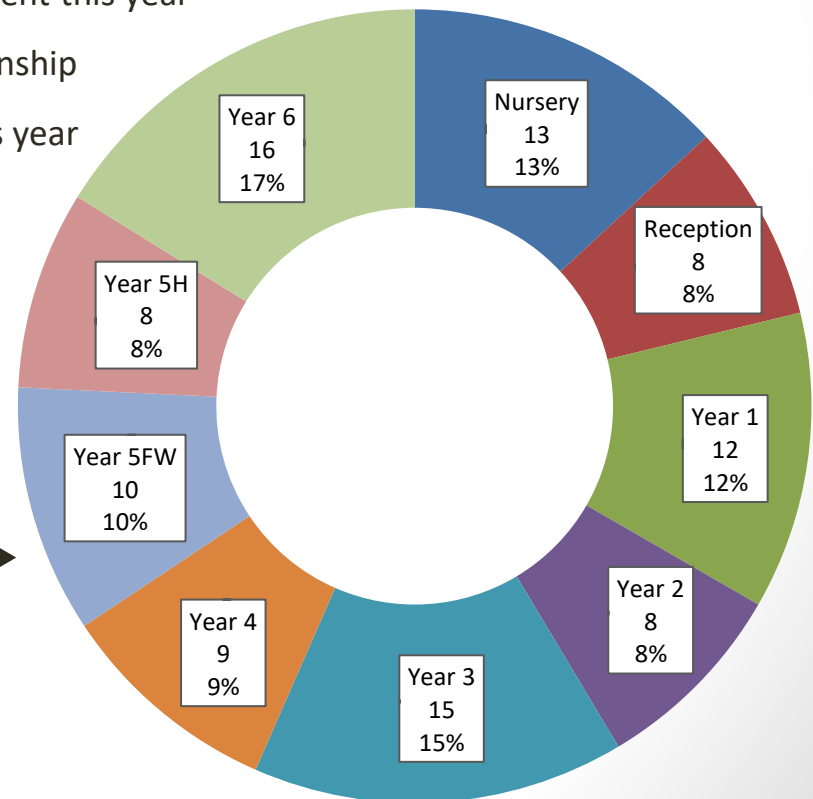

End of Academic Year Survey 2023

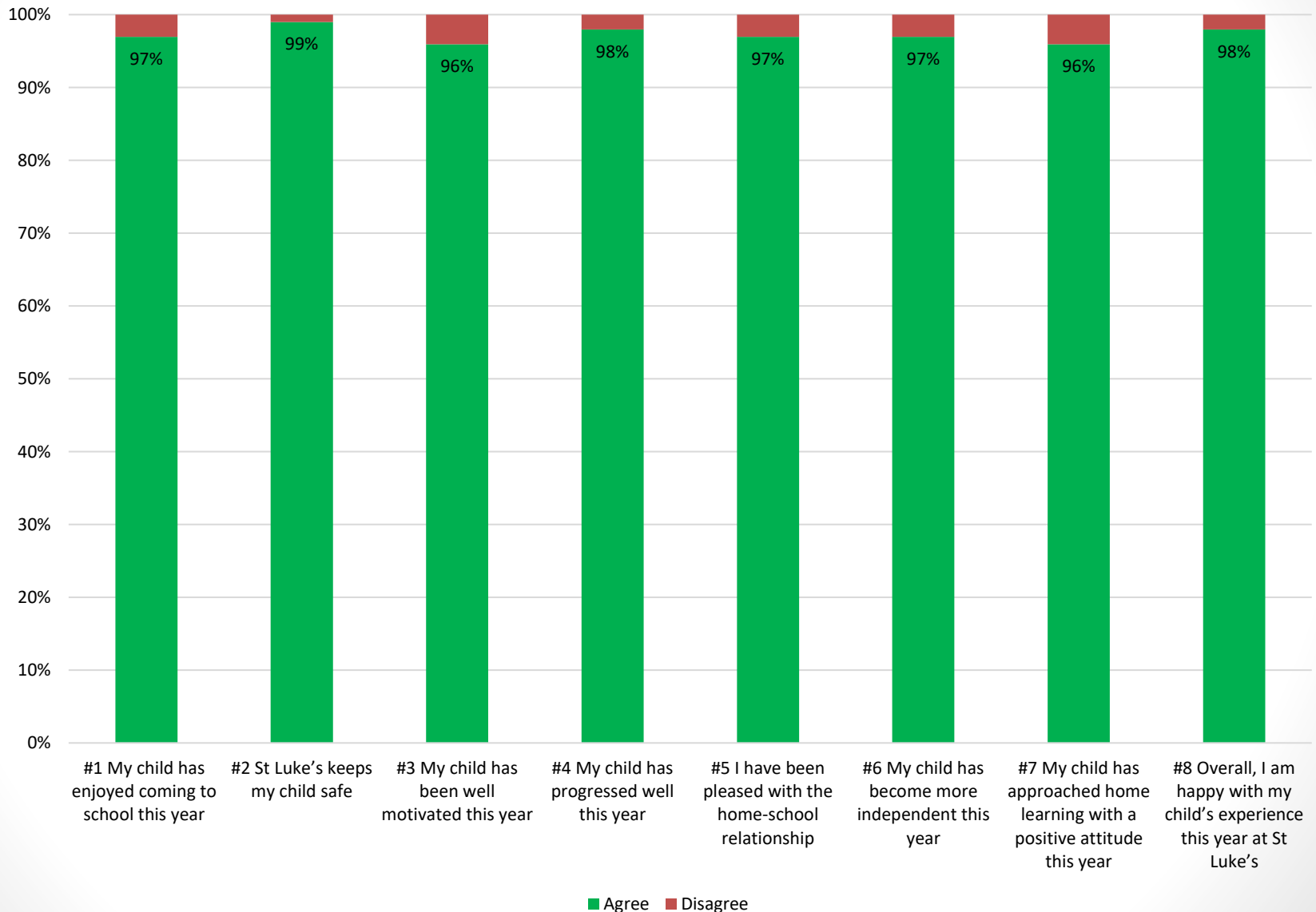
- The survey was completed using a Google Form. The survey saw a decrease (-5%) in the number of responses from the previous year - 36%.
