As it gets warmer, please ensure your child has a hat at school and is wearing suncream as we like to get outside as much as possible.

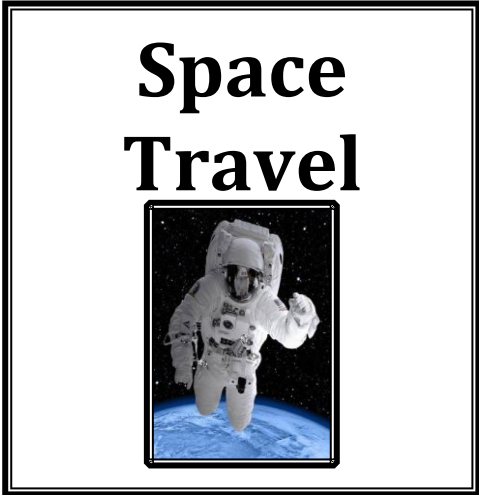
