

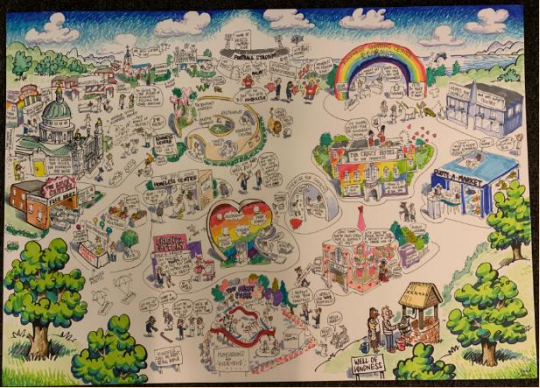
Art is an area of school life where there are no right or wrong answers, the children, can express themselves free from academic restraints allowing all children to shine and in turn building their confidence.
