

~ Vision of PSHE/RSE at St. Luke's School ~

At St Luke's we want to provide pupils with the knowledge, understanding, values and skills they need in order to lead confident, healthy and independent lives with the emphasis on developing positive relationships.

At St Luke's we want children to develop an understanding of the world around them, compassion for others, and the courage and confidence to be themselves. We achieve this through daily worship and weekly PSHE/RSE lessons in the classroom. We follow a scheme of work called Jigsaw, which combines PSHE, emotional literacy, mindfulness, social skills and spiritual development.

Jigsaw is a whole school approach, with all year groups working on the same theme (Puzzle) at the same time. The different puzzle pieces are: Being Me in My World, Celebrating Difference, Dreams & Goals, Healthy Me and Relationships.

PSHE is interwoven within the unique Christian fabric of St Luke's - a Church of England School.
