Current parents really only care about term dates and clubs in my opinion and that should be front and centre. I would suggest a simple self segmentation option on the front page for parents for prospective students and the parent section be designed for exactly what current parents needs are. All of the other stuff is irrelevant in my mind as a current parent.

The new website is fabulous. The layout and structure on both a laptop screen and mobile phone is displayed clearly and easily to navigate & read.

The curriculum information is much more intuitive to find and very comprehensive.

The School News app provides a great support for the school calendar so you exactly what is on when.



What could be improved about the website?

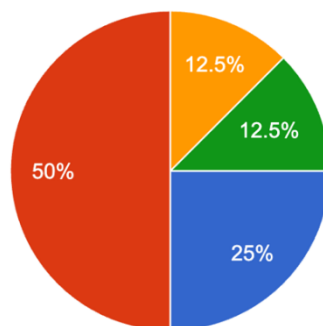

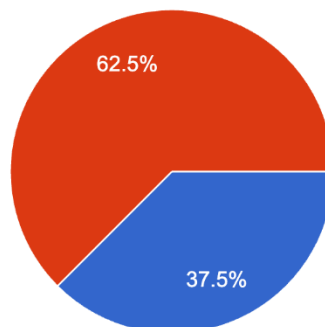

Is the information you need readily accessible on the website?

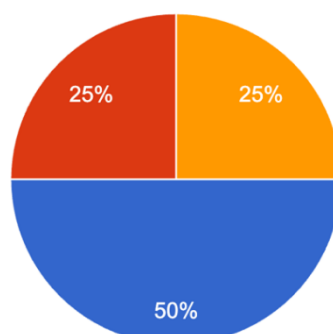

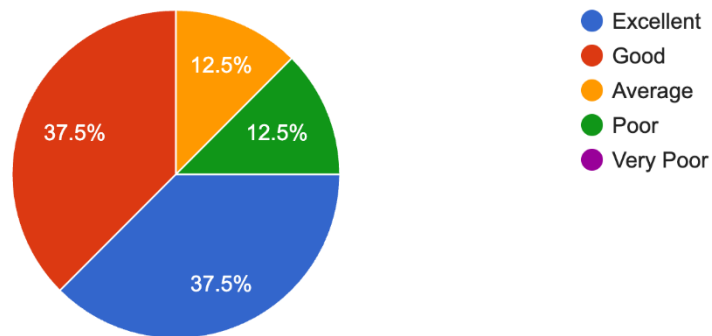

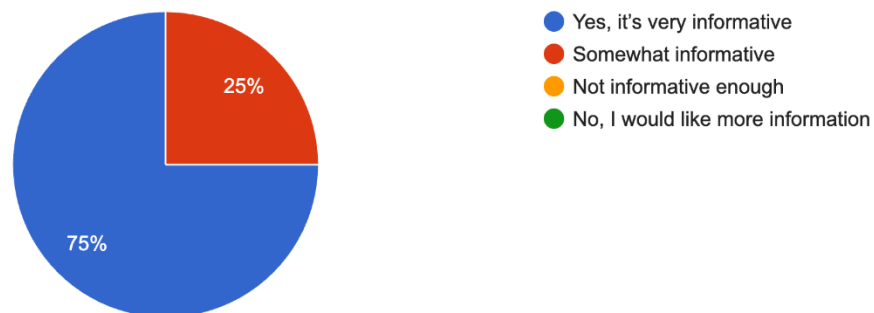
How would you rate the overall design and layout of the website?

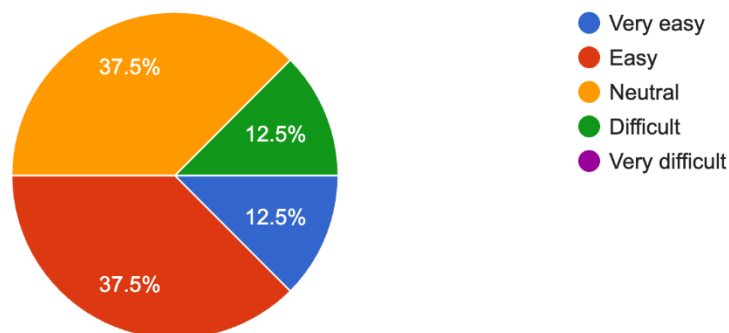
Do you feel the website provides sufficient information about school policies, events, and updates?

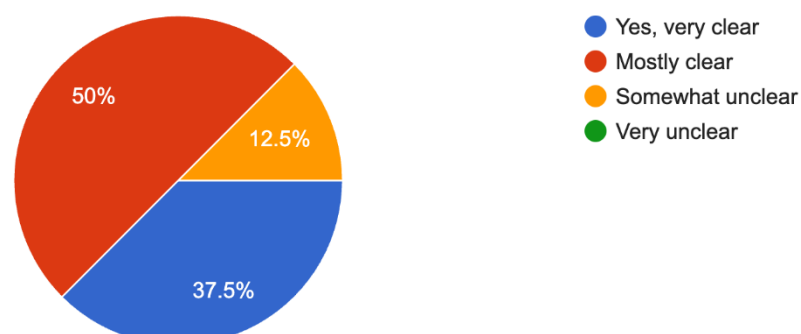
How easy is it to find key information about your child's class on the website?

Is the information about the school's curriculum clear and easy to understand?

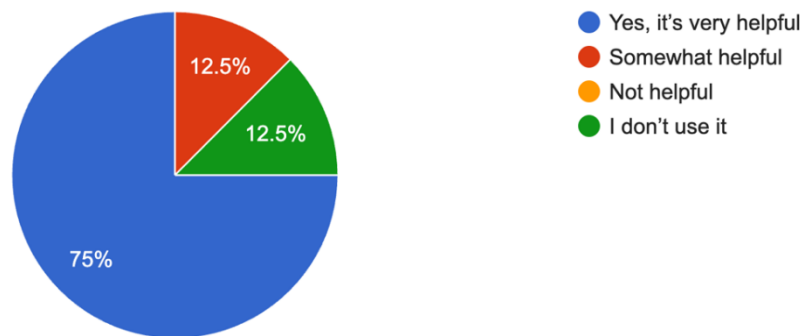

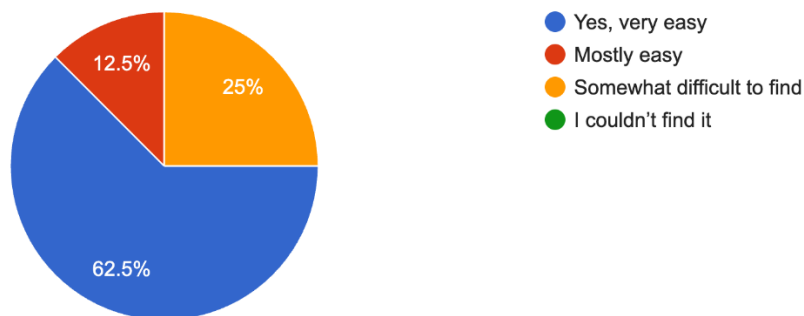
Do you find the events calendar helpful?
