RE: September arrangements

Thank you so much for your support during this extremely challenging academic year, it is very much appreciated by everybody.

I am delighted to say that we can go back to having the same times across the school from September. The Elm Road student entrance will be open and supervised from 8:30am to 8:50am. There will no longer be staggered times for different year groups and all children should arrive between these times.

We will continue to operate a relaxed entry system in the morning and children should say goodbye to parents at the gate and then go straight into class. The gate will be closed at approximately 8:50am. Please do not drop children off at school before 8:30am unless they are attending the Breakfast club or a before-school extra-curricular club (Acre Road entrance).

At the end of the day, children in KS1 and EYFS will finish at 3:10pm and KS2 at 3:15pm. Parents should still come and wait outside the classroom door to collect their children. The Elm Road gate will be opened shortly before 3:10pm.

Face coverings do not need to be worn on school grounds although parents may choose to wear them if they wish.

As mentioned in the newsletter last week, we have been told that from September the bubble system will no longer be in operation. Therefore, only children who test positive for COVID-19 will isolate. We will still remain vigilant with our procedures in school (see our updated Risk Assessment), but we have lost too many days in school this past 16 months and we in school are all pleased that this will end. We expect to receive additional guidance about this during the summer holidays and we will update you if necessary.

Thank you again for your patience and understanding. We are looking forward now to September with excitement and a determination to provide excellent education and care for every one of our children.
