

ST LUKE'S C.E. PRIMARY SCHOOL
PUPIL PREMIUM REPORT - ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020

The total pupil premium funding for St Luke's School for the first seven months of the academic year was £20,172. The funding for the following 5 months was £13,565 (see table below). The total for the academic year 2019-20 was £33,737.
