Tues 29 Nov	Toys and books Large and small toys but must be complete and unbroken. Good quality children's and adults' books.
Weds 30 Nov	Chocolates for the chocolate tombola Donations of boxes and bars of chocolates ... decent enough to make kids want to buy a raffle ticket! PLEASE REMEMBER WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL
Thurs 1 Dec	Secret gifts Donations of unwanted gifts in a new condition. Children will have the chance to choose gifts on the day and have them wrapped in secret for a friend or relative. .
