WITH KATHERINE RUNDELL

What inspired you to write the 'Impossible Creatures' books?

About ten years ago, I had the idea of a girl with a coat that allowed her to fly, but only when the wind blew. I knew that I wanted to write a world large enough for that girl to fly in; one that readers would want to return to again and again.



Which mythical creature would you most like to meet in real life?

I'd love to meet a jaculus dragon: small enough to fit in a teacup but with enough fire to burn down a city. My jaculus is called Jacques, and he has the personality of a slightly drunk, frequently irate professor.



What is your favourite thing about writing these books?

I loved researching the mythical creatures; hunting in libraries and old archives for creatures like the borometz, a sheep that grows from a tendril in the earth, and the kludde, a bloodthirsty wolf-dog with ears of fire.

FIRE AT MIDSUMMER

Every year, the citizens of the Glimouria Archipelago celebrated the longest day of the year with a feast. Tonight, while the sky would deepen to navy and the moon would rise, it would never grow dark. Glimourians would gather to eat Midsummer cake, traditionally as large as a bicycle wheel and tall as a smallish horse. They would drink dryad wine, and salute the glory of the light.

Midsummer celebrations varied across the thirty-four islands of Glimouria according to custom. On the Island of Antiok, centaurs galloped around great bonfires which sparked red and purple and blue. And in the fishing village of Arno on the Island of Arvatana, murder was being done.

Arno was made up of small, sturdy houses and a patchwork of meadows. It was home to herds of tiddy mun, a bog creature which conjured mist every night. The tiddy mun caused the meadows of mistflowers to thrive, the petals of which were used in the making of medicines and ointments, the principal trade of the island. It was a lush, wet, flourishing place.

It was hard, but not impossible, to burn.

Two dozen men, masked and armed, swarmed into the quayside market that morning. They came with crossbows and lances and torches, and they burned and slaughtered their way through the square. The sky swallowed the villagers' cries as it grew black with smoke and the houses flared to ruins and the meadows to ash. The men were ruthless and fast, trained in death.

They were not, though, unwatched. A ship called the *Fair Warning* had drawn alongside the coast with an intention to land. The ship's owner was Vigo Nex, a man with a diamond set in his canine tooth and morals so loose they flapped when he walked. But though he was a pirate, he was not a fool. He held up a fist to signal to his crew.

'Pull out, fast! Get out of range of the shore.'

Vigo put a glass to his eye. It was centaur-made, and allowed him to see every smear of soot on the cheeks of the terrified villagers who stood bound and captive by the quay.

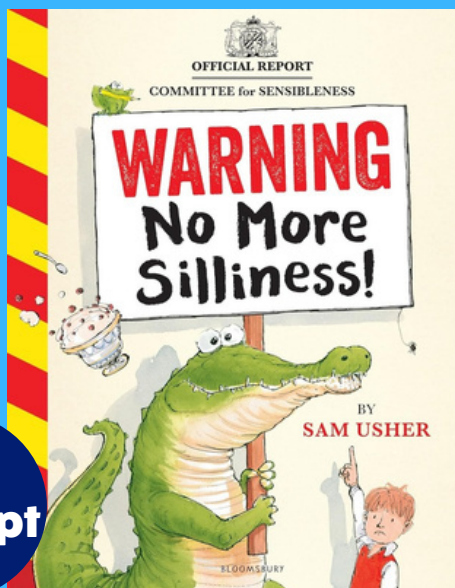

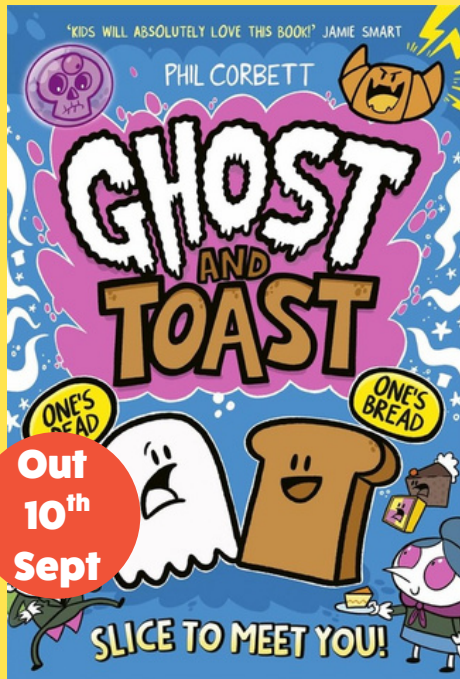

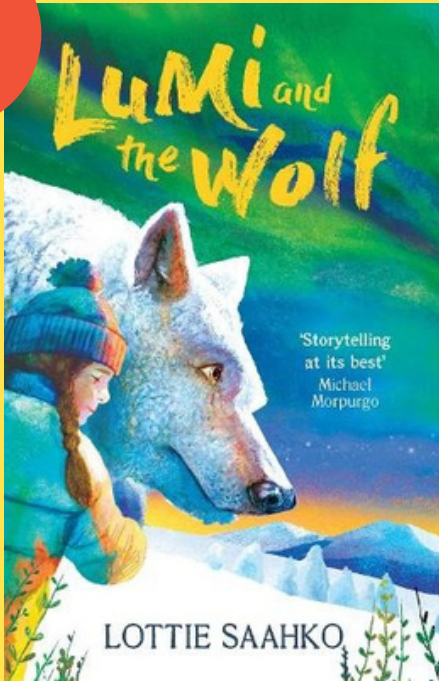
