# KS1 – Y1 & Y2

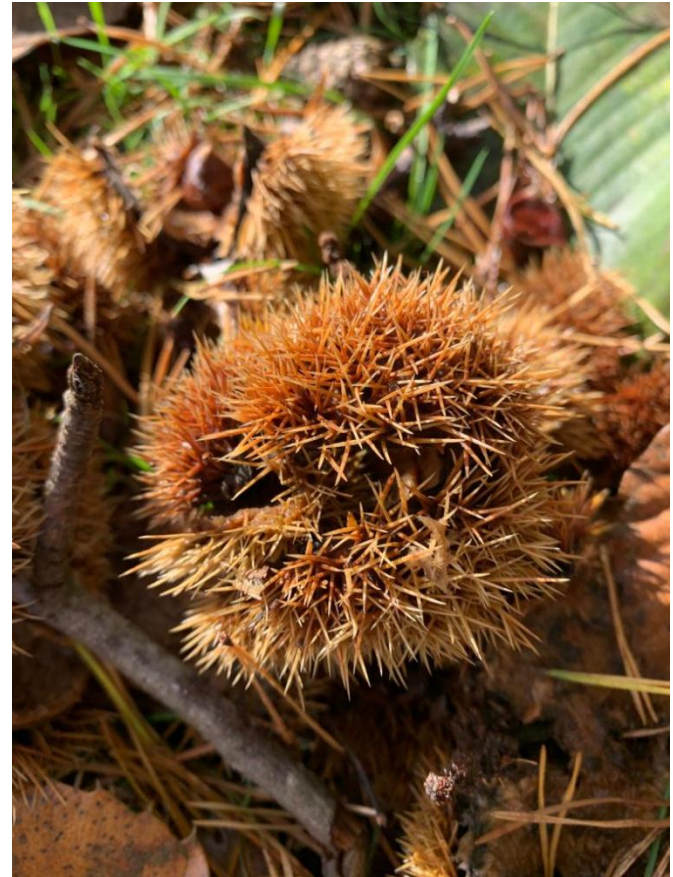
